## Staff & Students

- Daily health screening of staff and students
- Mask wearing required 3rd-6th, and encouraged TK-2nd
- Hand washing when entering classrooms

## Campus & Classroom

- Social distance decals and reminders throughout campus
- Safe squares for social distancing of 6 ft
- Desk shields for grades TK-2
- Remain to the right when walking to and from on campus

## Breaks & Lunch

- Scheduled bathroom breaks
- Unscheduled bathroom breaks logged and supervised
- Water fountains closed, labeled water bottles recommended
- Cohort A Grab and go lunches to be enjoyed on the same day
- Cohort B Grab and go lunches to be enjoyed the following day

## Daily, Routine, and Deep Cleaning

- Hourly bathroom cleaning
- Classroom fogging 2x per day
- Regularly scheduled classroom cleaning 2x per day
- Full campus deep cleaning on Wednesdays

## Other

- Designated grade level gates for arrival and drop off
- No bus transportation
- Daycare begins on grade level start date and closed on Wednesdays
- One person in the front office at one time
- No visitors or parents permitted on campus
- Meetings held virtually via Zoom
- Health room or well room for student head injuries and regular bumps and bruises
- Sick room or Med bay for all Covid/flu/illness related students
